- (3) Costello, France, Italy. 4 flak guns. No flak holes. No fighters. Steel mill.
- (4) Piombino, Italy. No flak. No fighters. No holes. Marshalling yards.

- (5) Milan, Italy. 10 flak guns. 4 fighters seen. No flak holes. Wop aircraft factory.
- (6) Jurru Severin, Rumania. Marshalling yards. 8 flak guns. 8 flak holes. No fighters.
- (7) Jurra Severin, Rumania. Same target. 8 flak guns. No fighters. 2 flak holes.
- (8) (9) Weiner Austria Neusbadt. 90 flak guns. 3 fighters. 1 flak hole. M.E.109 factory.
- (10) Bronzala, Italy. 76 flak guns. 2 holes. Marshalling yards.
- (11) Ferrara, Italy. 40 flak guns. 2 holes. Marshalling yards.
- (12) Avezzano, N. Italy. No flak. No fighters. Support of ground troops to disorganize German retreat.
- (13) Aviso, N. Italy. Flak. 5 fighters. Two shot down bridge.
- 7-(14) Venisoieux, France. Longest mission ever pulled from here. 7-1/2 hrs. Marshalling yards and round houses. Smashed target. Flak, heavy type. 15 fighters, but we weren't able to see them. Up to now, I haven't fired a round of ammo.
  - (15) St. Etienne, France. Marshalling yards and round houses. Not target scheduled. Longer mission than yesterday. No flak. No fighters.

- (16) Avignon, S. France. Marshalling yards. Boy, we really smashed them. Heavy flak but no fighters. Germans are slowly getting wise to us. The sky was black with our bombers.
- (17) (18) Overpfaffenhofen, near Munich. (Austria) 197 flak guns.got the hell shot out of us. A few fighters near air field. Munich.
- (19) (20) Budapest, Hungary. Oil refinery. Smashed target. Hell of a lot of flak. No fighters.
- (21) (22) Vienna, Austria. Oil refineries. Smashed target. Terrific flak. Large holes left in ship. Rear caught in ball.
- (23) Farnova di Farce, Italy. Marshalling yards and oil dump. Terrifically accurate flak. More holes in ship than I can count.
- (24) (25) Ploesti, Rumania. Lots of heavy flak, but inaccurate. We hit a refinery. Had bomb trouble. Load 2-2000 lb. bombs and 2-1000 lb. bombs.
- (26) Este, S. France. Harbor, installations and marshalling yards. Flew it on my birthday. Smashed target.
- (27) Bard, Yugoslavia. Marshalling yards. Smashed target. Alternate main target was in Germany proper.
- (28) Weather bad. We got over Hungary and had to feather an engine. Losing altitude fast, so we had to salvo bombs in a field. Got credit for one mission.
- (29) Rumania. Bridge (railroad). Smashed target. No flak, a few fighters. Piotro, Altul.
- (30) Montpellier, S. France. Marshalling yards. Hit target good. Had a good look at M. E. 109 today. Very accurate flak.
- (31) (32) Blachhammer, Germany. Oil refinery. Terrific flak. Smashed target.
- (33) (34) Vienna, Austria. Had a windmilling prop and it was darn near finis for us. We came all the way from Austria by ourselves. Had the hell shot out of us on the way back.
