Be it resolved by the Legislature of Alabama, both houses concurring, that that strip of road in Pike County, Alabama, known as Highway 201, which connects U.S. Highway No. 29 South, from a point one mile East of Banks, Alabama, to Alabama Highway No. 93 at a point two miles Southeast of Banks, Alabama, near the Atlantic Seaboard Railroad and Bethel Baptist Church is hereby designated and shall be known as "The William Bartley Crawley Road."

Be it further resolved, that the state highway department is authorized and directed to have erected and maintained at the entrances to the road appropriate signs or markers designating the road as hereabove provided.
