- 4th. "Jimmey Cricket" Kaput, after 35 days. Killed by RHONG!!!.
- >11th. 1st Anniversary of being shot down and taken Prisoner of War by Germany.
- 12th. Set down our Xmas "brew" in wooden tub. Contents: raisins, prunes, sugar, yeast, water.
- 14th. Big event of the Kriegie betting season !!!!!!!???" Two Americans lost a Warbet, and kept up their end of the agreement by kissing another's rear end. One of coldest days I ever knew.

- 15th Had phonograph & records all day - Thanks to Pete Mallinack & Jim Kramer
- 21st Big "raisin" party (Flagstaff sick)
- 23rd Xmas parcels 4 per 5 men.
- 24th Composed open till 1AM. Charlie Hart's Ragamuffin's show.
- 25th Merry Xmas - turkey dinner

- 3rd Sonny Schlossberg's show - "So What"
- 5th Light bulb cut down to half wattage
- 13th Big Russian winter offensive started
- 14th Jewish move to North Compound.
- 18th Naughton & Haines taken away to their Prison Fortress to serve 18 mo. court martial sentence.
- 22nd Redcross parcels in after 3 wks. famine
- 23rd Snow storm - Ft. deep.
- 26th. Forced to take 6 more men in room. Now have 24.

- 1st. Power went off about 9:30 P.M. - along with it water supply.
- 2nd. Began using rain water & snow for cooking & drinking purposes.
- 3rd. All day without power.
- 6th. Got "Groan-box" & records.
- 7th. Q. Meyer arrived, along with 1500 Kriegie Sergeants from various camps east of here. Had rough time.
- 8th. Air raid at night - activity at air field.
- 9th. No lights & water. Cooking and eating by Kriegie lights.
- 13th Officer sent to "cooler" for having hands in pocket at parade. No lights again.
- 21st. No red cross food parcels for a week. Still no lights.
- 24th. West Front offensive started. Still no food parcels.
- 26th. 3 cats missing. Were killed & eaten in Block 7.
- 27th. Yano committed suicide. Redcross parcels issued 1 per 4 men.

24th Long awaited offensive on West Front announced. Come IKE!
25th Still no food parcels. By Essen tho. Horseburgers from kitchen.
26th Red Cross food parcels arrived at long last. WHEEEEEE!
27th Red Cross parcels issued 1 per 4 men. First issue in a month.
28th More parcels issued 1 per 4 brought up to 1 per man. Also good news
29th Canadian died (Audie) from cerebral hemorrhage.
Camp morale & optimism running very very high - News still good
