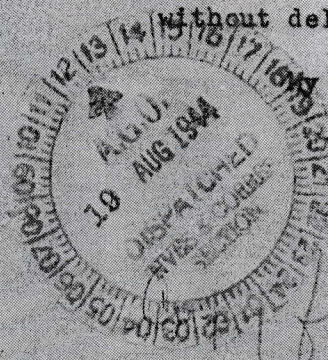
Please be assured that the military authorities are making every effort to determine the whereabouts of our missing personnel and when a report is received concerning your son, his wife will be notified without delay.
