

Truman Appoints Six to CCC Board

WASHINGTON. (AP). President Truman Friday gave recess appointments to six department of agriculture officials as members of the board of directors of the Commodity Credit corporation.

Albert J. Loveland of Iowa; Knox T. Hutchinson of Tennessee; William B. Crawley, of Alabama; Ralph S. Trigg of New Mexico; Frank K. Woolley of Indiana, and Elmer F. Kruse of Ohio.

The CCC is a \$4,850,000,000 corporation whose principal job is to finance the government's farm price support program.

As of July 31 last the corporation had \$2,450,000,000 invested in farm products taken over under the support program.
